Welcome Ruggers!

On behalf of the entire organizing committee, the Milwaukee Barbarians, and all our volunteers, I extend to you a very warm Milwaukee welcome to the 36th annual Lakefront 7s rugby tournament and festival! We are really excited for this year's event and we hope you are as well.

First and foremost, a big THANK YOU to all 92 tackle teams and 36 tag teams attending this year. Participation is the second-highest in the event's history and we are very near capacity. We consider this a big achievement given that we are not a Midwest Qualifier this year. In addition, we are proud to report that participation is growing in important ways. We have 24 High School teams and 32 Women's teams - both a record for the Lakefront 7s.

Our sponsors are also returning almost without exception. This includes long-time sponsors like Athletico Physical Therapy and Johnsonville Sausage, but also new sponsors like ECM Vacuum Furnaces. Rugby Athletic has signed a new sponsorship deal that runs through 2022 while the Orthopaedic Hospital of Wisconsin has made a 3-year commitment. Sponsors make our event possible so please do review their services throughout this program.

On the community side of the event, we're thrilled to be working with numerous corporate partners in our annual Hunger Task Force food drive. To help reach our goal of 1000 pounds of collected food we've purchased the parking rights at Veterans Park. Drivers can get free parking by contributing 32oz or more of peanut butter. If you have not yet participated in the food drive, please do keep it mind for next year.

On the organizational front, the Lakefront 7s team is also growing and improving (see our team above). Our administrative assistant Cathy Nirschl and her spouse Ben have stepped into the Tournament Director role along with Joseph Kloiber. We're also fortunate and thankful for the help of Milwaukee Barbarians alumnus Mike Rudy as well as active players such as Joe Grams and Ben Bastian. And of course a big THANK YOU to our outgoing tournament director Erik Schleicher for three years of excellent service.

In closing, I'd like to extend a very early invitation to the 2019 Lakefront 7s festival. The event will be held on Saturday, June 29th with the Papa Joe Golf Outing on Friday June 28th. We hope to see you there!

RUGBY SEVENS FOR BEGINNERS

So you're new to the game of Rugby Sevens? The Lakefront 7s is here to help with this beginners guide to the game so you can follow all the action on the pitch in Milwaukee.

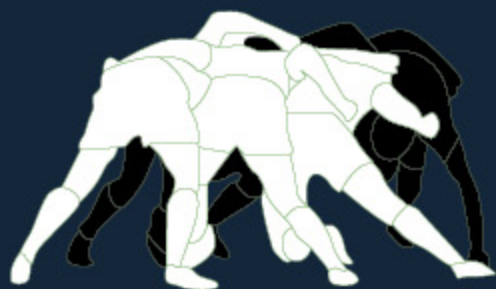
GAMEPLAY

- Rugby Sevens is a team-based, open-field game.
- The object of the game is to move the ball downfield and score.
- The ball may be passed laterally or backward, never forward.
- The ball can only be advanced by running or kicking the ball forward.
- There is no blocking, and only the ball carrier may be tackled.



Each match consists of two, 7-minute halves.

Only 3 people per team in scrums or lineouts.

TOURNAMENT

- Men's and Women's teams are organized by skill level into brackets.
- Brackets of 4 play round robin format to identify seeds for playoffs.
- Top seed(s) in each bracket advance to semi-finals.
- Winners of the semi-finals advance to the championship match.
- When applicable, Qualifier teams are awarded points to help qualify for Nationals.



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RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

Personal Code of Conduct

The Lakefront 7s hosts teams and spectators with a varied degree of rugby experience, including a significant number of minors. As such, we expect all participants and spectators to adhere to a basic code of conduct so as not to endanger themselves or others nor jeopardize the success and reputation of the tournament.

Some examples of proper conduct expected from all attendees include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Please do not change kit out in the open, as it is imperative that we maintain good relations with the people that are allowing us to use these fields. Either bring a tent to change in or use the available rest rooms.

- Restrooms are available, so please use them (and not just for changing kit).

- Alcohol consumption is permitted on-site, but please mind the minors and their parents who are attending. All attendees are expected to drink responsibly and arrange for any transportation in advance as public transit is NOT available at the tournament venue.

- Garbage and recycling containers are provided. Make every effort to use them throughout the day, and do a final 'sweep' of your area when you are leaving the venue.

- Rugby is a full-contact sport and on-field safety is the first responsibility of all players, coaches, referees and other participants. Ensure that you and your teammates are familiar with and practice safe rugby technique at all times.

Check-in & Schedule

Team representatives must check in at the scorer's table at least 60 minutes prior to their first scheduled match. Each team in the tournament will play 3 matches regardless of division, barring unforeseen forfeits.

Schedules and brackets will be posted online at lakefront7s.com. Please note that posted schedules and brackets are TENTATIVE and subject to change at the discretion of the tournament directors. We strongly suggest that you check the schedule for possible changes the evening before the tournament. Final schedules and brackets will be posted on-site at the event in the scoring and concessions area (see map).

Eligibility & Roster

Rosters will be limited to 12 players for USA Rugby Qualifier matches, or 15 players otherwise. Players in any Old Boys bracket must be at least 35 years old. High School players must be under 19 and have NOT played any college rugby. Each team must submit a roster/waiver form to the tournament director prior to starting play.

A player may only play for one team in one bracket and playing of an individual that is not on the team roster will result in the forfeiture of that match. A player sent off for any reason will be considered OUT of the tournament and not permitted to play for another team.

As of June 18, 2016 and following World Rugby Sevens Law Variation 3.4, a team may substitute the same player more than once as long as no more than 5 substitutions are made in total in any one game.

Venue & Format

All matches will be played at Veterans' Park. Matches will be played every 20 minutes (i.e. 8:00, 8:20, 8:40, etc...) and will consist of two, 7-minute halves and a 2-minute half-time. Teams more than 2 minutes late for a scheduled match will forfeit that match.

To provide appropriate competition for all participants, the tournament is organized into Divisions based on age, gender and skill-level. The teams in each division are then sorted into one or more brackets that will compete in Seeding Rounds (round-robin format) and Playoff Rounds. Each team will play 3 matches in the Seeding Round (barring unforeseen forfeits). The format of the Seeding Round and advancement to the Playoff Rounds is based on the total number of teams in the Division and will be displayed on-site during the event.

In the event of a tie during the Seeding Round, the following tie-breakers will be used: (i) Most games won, (ii) Head to head, (iii) Points scored, (iv) Point differential, (v) Coin Toss.

In case of a tie in Playoff Rounds, 'sudden death' overtime will determine the winner. Sudden death periods will be 5 minutes in duration with a 1-minute break. These periods will continue until a team scores.

Disciplinary

Yellow cards will last for 2 minutes.

A player sent off (red card) during any match is ineligible for the remainder of the tournament. Two yellow cards in a single match is a red card.

The on-site tournament director will solely adjudicate any other issues not directly addressed herein.

ABOUT THE LAKEFRONT 7s

Lakefront 7s began as a small rugby tournament in Milwaukee in the summer of 1982. From those humble beginnings, the Lakefront 7s has grown into a rugby festival featuring 100+ teams across all age groups. The Lakefront 7s has also hosted teams from around the world, numerous qualification events for USA Rugby, and the Championship Cup Series (USA Sevens LLC).

Lakefront 7s is organized by members of the Milwaukee Barbarians Athletic Club (formerly the Milwaukee West Side Harlequins and Milwaukee RFC) and their friends and family. For decades, the event was organized by Papa Joe Kloiber — founder of the West Side Harlequins and the Lakefront 7s — and his family members who continue to play an important role in the event.

On the 30th anniversary of the event in 2012, Papa Joe received a Lifetime Achievement Award for his tireless efforts to promote rugby in Milwaukee and throughout Wisconsin.
